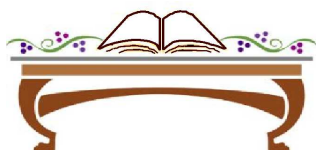
JOHN & CHARLES WESLEY Anglican Commemoration March 3

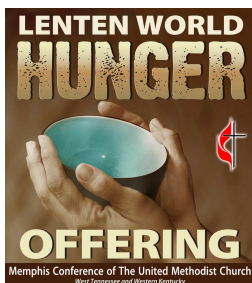
